Interview with Mr. N. Kinnock
Radio Ulster, 24.1.87

Mr. Kinnock: As I've said many times ... our people to meet with elected representatives from all the parties and that's of course what they did. All the attention has been given to the encounter with Sinn Fein. I think equal validity should be given to the exchanges that Peter and Stewart had with others. Now, the second point is this. We never miss the opportunity, nor do they miss the opportunity, to say how very profoundly we disagree with the so-called dual strategy which continues to be unacceptable to us. My view is that I don't meet with Sinn Fein. I don't think it would be productive in any way for me so to do but as part of a general series of meetings with representatives from all parties of people in Northern Ireland as long as they are duly elected I think it is appropriate for the Labour Party spokespeople so to do.
