VISIT OF PRESIDENT CLINION TO IRELAND

1. The White House have been in contact with us again this morning in follow-up to last week's Conference and proposing the dates of 29 September to 1 October for a visit to London, Belfast and Dublin by President Clinton. These dates have now been agreed by the British and we have been asked for our formal confirmation as soon as possible (we have, as you know, informally agreed to them last week, which the U.S. very much appreciated). The visit essentially comprises a weekend. The White House say that the legislative agenda here makes it imperative that the President be back in Washington for Monday, 2 October.

2. The White House have outlined the possible itinerary as follows:

Fridav, 29 September


- Arrive London

- Overnight London.


Saturday, 30 September
