Irish Justice Minister Brian Lenihan made the call as he opened a parliamentary debate on the brutal October 20 killing of Paul Quinn in a shed in Co Monaghan.

As Mr Quinn `s father Stephen and other close relatives looked on from the Dail`s public gallery, cross-party TD expressed sympathy and called for the perpetrators to be brought to justice.
Stephen and Briege Quinn have led a high-profile cross Border campaign and met the Taoiseach and Foreign Affairs Minister Dermot Ahern in Dublin in December.

Mr Quinn`s parents have blamed members of the IRA for the death of their 23-year-old son, whom they claimed had defied orders to leave the country by the terrorist group.

However the Irish Government claims the Garda has no information to suggest the attack was authorised by or carried out on behalf of the IRA.

Mr Quinn died in hospital after being severely beaten by a gang of up to a dozen men wielding iron bars and wearing balaclavas and boiler suits.

Mr Lenihan today told the Bail: "It is vitally important that people with information which might help find the people responsible and bring them to justice make it known.
