## Alliance motion on Omagh bomb fails

An Alliance Party motion calling for full disclosure of information held by the intelligence services and security forces on the Omagh bomb has failed in the Assembly.

However a DUP amendment has been passed with support from the Ulster Unionists.

Ian Paisley said they couldn't back the Alliance because their motion failed to condemn the Real IRA bombers.

Alliance motion on Omagh bomb fails - Local News - UTV Northern Ireland SDLP leader Mark Durkan said the onus was on the governments in Dublin or London to answer the pleas of the families: "We should be as angry and aggrieved as many of those Omagh families," he said. UUP MLA for Fermanagh and South Tyrone, Tom Elliot said there was a danger May 2006 full disclosure could compromise ongoing operations against dissident republicans: "There is a likelihood that any investigation will not be what the victims` families hoped for," he added.
