King spoke only to confirm his name and that he understood the charge

he faced during his appearance at Craigavon Magistrates' Court today.

Detective Sergeant Michael Hamilton told the court he could connect him with the charge.

What are these?

The officer said that, when the charge was put to him during police interview, the defendant replied: "Definitely not quilty, I should not be charged with this offence."

King was remanded in custody to appear at the same court via video link on October 10.
