Families unite to solve murders

Families of four murder victims named in a report on RUC Special Branch collusion with loyalist killers are to sue the chief constable.

The families of Peter McTasney, Gerard Brady, Sharon McKenna and John Harbinson have all joined forces to launch a civil action against the police in a bid to uncover the truth behind the murders.

Police Ombudsman Nuala O'Loan said some Special Branch officers gave immunity to a UVF murder gang in North Belfast.

The families issued legal papers which allege negligence during investigations into a series of murders in the 1990s.

A delegation of relatives delivered a letter to PSNI headquarters, outlining their intention to seek compensation on Monday morning.

Police Ombudsman Nuala O'Loan's report found some Special Branch officers colluded with loyalists behind over a dozen murders in North Belfast. This is just the first step in what the families know will be a lengthy litigation process but they say they are determined to fight on until justice is done.
