57,000 adults in Belfast, almost one in four have no vote at Council Elections.

They have no vote because they have no house. They are the young adults living with parents, the flat dwellers, the families crowded into one house and the homeless.

Most of these people will eventually want to own or rent a house for themselves. But since getting a house means getting a vote the "right" person must get the "right" house in the "right" area if councillors electorial majorities are not to be upset. Thus discrimination and blackmail in housing arises.

If O'Neill and the establishment abolish company votes it is but a trivial concession, a sop. There are only 228 company votes in all Belfast (0.1 percent).

We demand One Man One Vote and an end to corruption, discrimination and gerrymandering.
