#### LAW ENFORCEMENT, THE RULE OF LAW AND SINN FEIN "WORDS"

Sinn Fein/IRA is offering qualified verbal support for the PSNI and the Rule of Law in exchange for the right to govern and a fixed date for Sinn Fein/IRA in charge of policing, when they will show the police "who is Boss" and "put manners on them". Unionists must reject parties who would accept a deal putting Sinn Fein/IRA in government or ever having control of policing and justice.

#### RATES, WATER CHARGES, EDUCATION

No-one has been more active on these issues than Bob McCartney. Since June 2002, when the Assembly first proposed these methods of raising money, the UKUP leader has campaigned in the Press and Media, alerting the electorate. Until recently, the other parties who were complicit in the proposals did nothing. Bob has been a tireless advocate for the retention of our grammar schools which are the envy of the rest of the UK.

#### PARADES AND EQUALITY OF UNIIONIST CULTURE

The UUP and the DUP have claimed that St. Andrew's will make Northern Ireland a warmer place for Unionists, but the parades issue, and the discrimination against Protestant candidates for the PSNI, demonstrate that nothing positive has resulted.

#### ST. ANDREW'S AGREEMENT

In a number of ways this Agreement has reinforced rather than diminished Nationalist benefits under the Belfast Agreement. Sinn Fein will have a veto. It will have an Irish Language Programme and two further Cross Border institutions will be created.

# THE UNITED KINGDOM UNIONIST PARTY

- Does not oppose peace, but not peace at any price. The Union is more important than any party. First, the UUP under Trimble and now the DUP under Ian Paisley have put their party's interest and their personal ambition before the Union.
- By accepting Sinn Fein/IRA into government, the DUP is adopting Trimble's policies, which Unionists have rejected in two elections.

- Faced with the pro-Agreement policies of the DUP and the UUP, anti-Agreement Unionists can either stay at home and see the nationalist vote exceed theirs, or they can vote for the UKUP and other anti-Agreement candidates.
- The DUP is hiding the REAL TRUTH about the St. Andrew's Agreement and making bogus claims about the benefits it will offer Unionists. In many respects, it is worse than the Belfast Agreement

# THE TRUTH ABOUT ST. ANDREW'S

- St. Andrew's is not a new replacement of the Belfast Agreement. The central defects of the Belfast Agreement, like D'Hondt, remain. Any changes are merely cosmetic.
- Under St. Andrew's, Sinn Fein/IRA will exercise a veto over any Unionist proposal which requires cross community support.
- The DUP claim that it requires "deeds" not "words" from Sinn Fein on support for the Police and the Rule of Law is absurd, if an Executive is to be formed by 26th March 2007.
- Sinn Fein remains inextricably linked with the IRA which retains a range of weapons and a command and control structure. So-called dissident republicans are free to act as the agents of Sinn Fein.
- The DUP's claim to have obtained a "Financial Package" has been exposed as false. It has achieved no additional money for Northern Ireland and has failed to stop water charges provisions.
- The DUP assertion that it has capped rates is bogus. Sinn Fein is against capping and can exercise a veto on any change. In any case, capping will only help those with a house value of half a million plus.
- The retention of Academic Selection in principle is of no value if Sinn Fein and the SDLP can veto any new method of selection to replace the 11 plus examination.
- St. Andrew's will give the Irish Language equal status with English even though 96% of the population does not speak it. The cost of implementation will be enormous.
- St. Andrew's means that there will be no devolution unless the DUP accept Sinn Fein/IRA in government and the DUP appear willing to pay that price.
