At the special meeting of the Fianna Fail Party held at Leinster House, the Party unanimously endorsed a Motion by the Taoiseach that the Party approve such nominations as he would make to replace the members of the Government whose appointments had been terminated.

Each of the three former Ministers, Deputies Neal Blaney, Kevin Boland, and Charles J. Haughey and the former Parliamentary Secretary, Deputy Paudge Brennan, expressed unreservedly his loyalty to the Fianna Fail Party and the Taoiseach.
