Report on the Arrest, Interrogation and treatment of :-



Still detained in Crumlin 2d.

Age: 36

Occupation: Teacher.

- August 9. Arrested 4.30. Omagh 7. Magilligan 10.15
 Queationed by Adamson and Ginger (Omagh S.E.)
 - 10. Magilligan. In hut all day. No exercise.
 - 11. 4 a.m. Breakfast. Handcuifed singly. Bag over head.
 Est. 1 hour by copter. Rough treatment. Into torture.
 Back into copter in overalls. Est. 1 hour journey.
 Detention Order served. Back into copter. Est. 1 hour to torture.
- (August 11 17 Period of torture with head covered by bag all the time)
 - 17. Arrive Bylfast by copter approx. mid-day. Throughhole in wall. To prison hospital via short stry in basement cell. Doctor says 'chest caught'. Take milk sore, stiff. Black. See first papers week's news lost. Other prisoners hind.
 - 18. Parcel from to Cerd. via I in as Dep. Gov. to serve Det. Order. I said I was already served on 10th. Fr. D. back confused. First tasty meal. Confession Early.

M. 12 Intelligence printed on Envelopes.

Torture: Into boiler suit. Bag over head. Rough treatment

at all times. Made stand until 'Drop'.

Sounds: Compressed air escaping all the time. Moaning.

Death service. Hymns. Execution Order. Protest moans.

Firing shuad. Mob singing.

Food: Drinks of water rigely. Dry bread forced into mouth

afterwards. Refused. Approx. Sun. or Mon. Milk once.

Cereal once. Rice once. Unable to eat.

Doctor: Examined about 4 times. Said "If needed to 'dispatch'

him find me at 'The Country Club'.

Toilet: No. Wet where we lay. Slept in it. Approx. Mon.

toilet and shave.

Heard in copter(after Internment Order): "Back to The Wood' ".

Forms of Punishment Overleaf:

2 refused

Questioned roughly 8 times 2 faked 1. Englishman ata time

4 answered 2. No local knowledge.

Bag over head at all times -Noises all the time.

- 1. Stand against wall. Feet out until dropped with exhaustion. Fell early at first Refused.
- 2. Gaught by arms and legs Bounced up and down -Hitting ground with rectum.
- 3. Rolled along ground back and forth.
- 4. Carried on back, ppun around and dropped. "Heavy bastard -ain' he."
- 5. Punched winth fingers in stomach.
- 6. Arms screwed back.
- 7. Two arms straight back. Kneed in back.
- 8. Head between knees. Legs akimbo. Man sits on shoulders.
- Flat on back. Logs pressed wide. Privates kicked.
- 10. Arms behind pipes.
- 11. Head bumped on floor bringing dizziness.
- 12. Slamping face.
- 13. Dramming with knuckles behind ears.
- 34. Fulling chest hair.
- 15. Choking Holding nose and mouth and throat.
- 16. Thrown over a form head down, then feet down.
- 17. Arms winded like windmill.
- 18. Arms, hands beaten against ground.
- 19. Fingers stamped on.
- 20. Shoulders on ground Legs pulled forward. Man's weight pressed down.
- 21 BHatdef hands marked with Slue Dye. Powder like camphor.

22. Handcuffed and hung up.
