MOYNIHAN AND DODD AND OTHERS TOGETHER WITH ACCOMPANYING
STATEMENT:-

IN THE SENATE OF THE UNITED STATES

MR KENNEDY (FOR HIMSELF, MR MOYNIHAN, MR DODD, MR LEAHY, MR EAGLETON, MR LEVIN, MR INOUYE, MR HART, MR TSONGAS, MR PELL, MR CRANSTON, MR PROXMIRE, AND MRS WEICKER) INTRODUCED THE FOLLOWING JOINT RESOLUTION: WHICH WAS READ TWICE AND REFERRED TO THE COMMITTEE ON FOREIGN RELATIONS.

## ON THE HUNGER STRIKE IN NORTHERN TRELAND

TAKEN THE LIVES OF MORE THAN TWO THOUSAND MEN, WOMEN, AND CHILDREN IN THE PAST DECADE:

WHEREAS AN END TO THE KILLING AND THE VIOLENCE IN NORTHERN IRELAND CAN BE ACHIEVED ONLY THROUGH A POLITICAL SETTLEMENT WITH THE CONSENT OF ALL THE PARTIES:

WHEREAS CONGRESS IS DEEPLY CONCERNED OVER THE HUNGER STRIKE IN NORTHERN IRELAND AND THE DEATHS RESULTING FROM THE STRIKE:

RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF

THE UNITED STATES IN CONGRESS ASSEMBLED, THAT -

- (1) CONGRESS CONDEMNS THE VIOLENCE ON ALL SIDES IN NORTHERN IRELAND:
- (2) CONGRESS URGES THE PARTIES TO EXPLORE ALL POSSIBLE STEPS TO AVOID FURTHER DEATHS IN THE HUNGER STRIKE AND ACHIEVE AN IMMEDIATE AND HUMANITARIAN RESOLUTION OF THE ISSUES IN THE STRIKE:

(A) TO EXERCISE GREATER FLEXIBILITY IN THE ADMI-NISTRATION OF PRISON RULES IN NORTHERN IRELAND: AND

(B) TO INVITE THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS OR OTHER APPROPRIATE INDEPENDENT PARTIES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EFFORT TO SETTLE THE STRIKE:

- CONGRESS URGES THE POLITICAL LEADERS IN GREAT BRITAIN, NORTHERN IRELAND, AND THE REPUBLIC OF IRELAND TO SEEK THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE SETTLEMENT OF THE LARGER CONFLICT IN NORTHERN IRELAND THROUGH A NEGOTIATED AGREEMENT THAT ACHIEVES A LASTING PEACE, THAT HAS THE CONSENT OF ALL THE PARTIES, THAT RECOGNIZES THE RIGHTS OF BOTH THE CATHOLIC AND THE PROTESTANT COMMUNITY IN NORTHERN IRELAND, AND THAT SECURES FULL RESPECT FOR HUMAN RIGHTS OF ALL THE PEOPLE OF THAT LAND: AND
- CONGRESS REQUESTS THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES TO EXPRESS TO THE PRIME MINISTER OF GREAT BRITAIN THE CONCERN OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE FOR AN IMMEDIATE SETTLEMENT OF THE HUNGER STRIKE AND A LASTING SETTLEMENT OF THE CONFLICT IN NORTHERN IRELAND.

STATEMENT OF SENATOR EDWARD M KENNEDY INTRODUCING A RESOLUTION ON THE HUNGER STRIKE IN NORTHERN IRELAND.

NORTHERN IRELAND, AND I ASK THAT IT MAY BE REFERRED TO THE SENATE COMMITTEE ON FOREIGN RELATIONS.

THE DEATH OF FOUR HUNGER STRIKERS IN THE MAZE PRISON IN BELFAST IN RECENT WEEKS IS A SAD DAY FOR IRELAND AND FOR ALL WHO SEEK PEACE IN NORTHERN IRELAND AND AN END TO THE VIOLENCE THAT HAS CLAIMED SO MANY LIVES AND SCARRED SO MANY MORE IN THE PAST DECADE.

THE ANNOUNCEMENT THIS WEEK THAT MORE PRISONERS WILL JOIN THE HUNGER STRIKE IS A TRAGIC NEW ESCALATION OF THE CRISIS.

NOW, BEFORE ADDITIONAL DEATHS AND BLOODSHED OCCUR, IT IS ESSENTIAL FOR THE PARTIES TO MAKE AN URGENT EFFORT TO END THIS LETHAL STALEMATE AND TO ACHIEVE A FAIR AND HUMANITARIAN RESOLUTION OF THE ISSUES IN THE STRIKE.

THE JOINT RESOLUTION WE ARE INTRODUCING TODAY IS DESIGNED TO HELP THE PARTIES REACH THAT GOAL. IT CONTAINS FIVE SIGNIFICANT PROVISIONS:

-FIRST, IT CONDEMNS THE VIOLENCE ON ALL SIDES IN NORTHERN IRELAND.

STEPS TO END THE HUNGER STRIKE.

- THIRD, IT URGES THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT, WHICH HAS CLEAR RESPONSIBILITY FOR PRISON ADMINISTRATION IN NORTHERN IRELAND, TO EXERCISE GREATER FLEXIBILITY WITH RESPECT TO PRISON PROCEDURE. SURELY IT IS POSSIBLE TO ACHIEVE A REASONABLE COMPROMISE ON ISSUES SUCH AS CLOTHING, PRISON WORK REQUIREMENTS, AND THE ASSOCIATION OF THE PRISONERS, WITHOUT COMPROMISING IN ANY WAY ON THE BASIC PRINCIPLE OF OPPOSITION TO VIOLENCE. THIS PROVISION OF THE RESOLUTION ALSO CALLS ON BRITAIN TO INVITE THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION ON HUMAN RIGHTS OR OTHER APPROPRIATE INDEPENDENT PARTIES TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EFFORT TO SETTLE THE STRIKE. IN THE PAST, BRITAIN HAS IMPLEMENTED RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE COMMISSION WITH RESPECT TO THE MODIFICATION OF PRISON RULES, AND A SIMILAR INITIATIVE AT THIS TIME BY THE COMMISSION COULD PROVIDE THE BREAKTHROUGH NEEDED TO END THE CURRENT STRIKE.
- FOURTH, THE RESOLUTION URGES POLITICAL LEADERS IN BRITAIN, IRELAND, AND NORTHERN IRELAND TO SEEK THE EARLIEST POSSIBLE NEGOTIATED SETTLEMENT OF THE LARGER CONFLICT IN NORTHERN IRELAND. THAT SETTLEMENT MUST BE ACHIEVED WITH THE CONSENT OF ALL THE PARTIES. IT MUST RECOGNIZE THE RIGHTS OF BOTH THE CATHOLIC AND THE PROTESTANT COMMUNITY. AND IT MUST SECURE FULL RESPECT FOR THE HUMAN RIGHTS OF ALL THE PEOPLE OF NORTHERN IRELAND. THE HUNGER STRIKE IS A SYMPTOM OF A DEEPER CRISIS—A CRISIS THAT WILL GO ON AND ON IN NORTHERN IRELAND, UNTIL ALL WHO TRULY SEEK AN END TO THE VIOLENCE CARE ENOUGH TO SPEAK AND WORK FOR PEACE.
- TO THE PRIME MINISTER OF GREAT BRITAIN THE CONCERN OF THE AMERICAN PEOPLE FOR AN IMMEDIATE END TO THE HUNGER STRIKE AND A LASTING SETTLEMENT OF THE CONFLICT IN NORTHERN IRELAND. THE UNITED STATES HAS AN IMPORTANT ROLE TO PLAY IN THE SEARCH FOR PEACE, AND THE ADMINISTRATION SHOULD NOT HESITATE TO EXERCISE IT.

BEFORE MORE HUNGER STRIKERS DIE, BEFORE MORE LIVES ARE LOST IN VIOLENT DEMONSTRATIONS, BEFORE ALL THE HOPEFUL PROGRESS OF PAST MONTHS TOWARDS A NEGOTIATED SETTLEMENT IS LOST, IT IS TIME FOR BRITAIN TO ACT TO BREAK THIS ENDLESS SPIRAL OF DEATH IN NORTHERN IRELAND, SO THAT LEADERS OF GOOD WILL MAY RESUME THEIR EFFORT TO CREATE A LASTING PEACE.

WAS INTRODUCED BY SENATORS KENNEDY, MOYNIHAN, AND DODD.

- 2. IT IS EXPECTED THAT A RESOLUTION IN SIMILAR TERMS WILL BE INTRODUCED INTO THE HOUSE TODAY OR EARLY NEXT WEEK BY SHANNON (D-MASS) AND DOUGHERTY (R-PA). WE WILL KEEP YOU POSTED.
- 3. CONGRESSMAN BIAGGI PROPOSES ALSO TO TABLE A RESOLUTION TODAY ALONG THE FOLLOWING LINES:-

WHEREAS IRISH MEN ARE DYING ON A HUNGER STRIKE IN NORTHERN IRELAND, AND

WHEREAS WORLD PLEAS, INCLUDING ONE BY POPE JOHN PAUL II, HAVE BEEN REGISTERED, AND

WHEREAS THIS HOUSE DEPLORES ALL FORMS OF VIOLENCE,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE HOUSE EXPRESSES ITS DEEP CONCERN OVER THE HUNGER STRIKE AND CALLS UPON THE BRITISH GOVERNMENT TO EXERCISE GREATER URGENCY AND FLEXIBILITY IN FINDING A HUMANITARIAN SOLUTION.

RESOLUTIONS ONCE TABLED ARE REFERRED TO THE RESPECTIVE FOREIGN AFFAIRS COMMITTEES OF THE HOUSE AND THE SENATE WHERE, IN THE NORMAL COURSE OF THINGS, THEY TAKE THEIR PLACE ON THE AGENDA WITH ALL THE OTHER VARIOUS RESOLUTIONS SIMILARLY REFERRED.
