## Trade unionist takes on RTE censorship

## FREE SPEECH LEGAL FUND ... DEFEND FREEDOM OF SPEECH AND FREEDOM OF INF

During August 1990 the workers at the Gatacux Bakery in Finglas. North Dublin, were in dispute with their employer - the Allied Lyons Group of Britain. The workers in Gatacux elected a Strike Committee to defend their interests. They also elected Gateaux worker and Bakers Union National Executive member, Larry O'Toole, as the Strike Committee Chaiperson - in other works as the Gateaux workers' chief sookeperson.

The dispute gained a great deal of media attention in the newspapers and in

broadcasting organisations such as RTE. After first broadcasting an interview with Larry O'Toole on the FMZ 12 noon News, RTE thereafter banned Larry O'Toole from the airwaves. He was not allowed to represent the workers' point of view on RTE, even though he was the person the workers shought most qualified for the task.

The reason RTE Head of New, be Muholland, gave for censoring Larry O'Toole as the Gateaux workers' spokasperson is the "arry person who is a MUMBER (our emphasis) of Sine Fin., will not be permitted to braadcast on any RTE programma" under any circumstances. RTE's is an incorrect interpretation of its legal collipations under Section 31. Section 31 ODS KOT BAN SINN FERS is an incorrect RTE. The missikan impression that it does stems solely from RTE's ling a teaction 31 Order.

In fact the Section 31 Order from the government consors any person who is acting in the capacity of SPOKESPRESON or REPRESENTATIVE of Sinn Fein.
