

Copy of document received from students involved in Civil Rights  
Rights demonstration - 9th October, 1968

We gathered at a public meeting held in Queen's University on 9th October, 1968.

1. We demand that legislation be introduced to establish one-man one-vote at all levels of government.
2. That the Special Powers Act be repealed.
3. That the present Public Order Act be repealed.
4. That the Parliamentary Commissioner Act be introduced.
5. That the Flags and Emblems Act be repealed.
6. That the Human Rights Act introduced by Miss Murnaghan be passed.
7. (a) That a points system based on need alone be introduced for the allocation of Houses.  
(b) That the Housing Trust be obliged to provide Housing for the lowest paid workers and the unemployed.
8. That Electoral Boundaries be redrawn fairly.
9. That an impartial enquiry be carried out into allegations of Police Brutality in Londonderry on Saturday, 5th October.
10. That jobs be allocated on basis of ability alone.
