The Prime Minister has announced that Lord Cameron, a Senator of the College of Justice and Lord of Session in Scotland, has agreed to accept the Chairmanship of the Commission which is to be established to consider the disturbances in Northern Ireland.

Captain O'Neill said today:- "I am sure all of us who look to this Commission for a thorough and objective review will be delighted that it is to be headed by such a distinguished member of the Scottish Judiciary. We hope to be in a position to complete the membership at an early date".

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE The Honourable Lord Cameron (John Cameron) was born in 1900 and educated at Edinburgh Academy and Edinburgh University. He served in both Wars with the R.N.V.R. and in the second was awarded the D.S.C. and mentioned in despatches.

An Advocate since 1924, he served as Dean of the Faculty of Advocates from 1948-55 in which year he was appointed to the Court of Session. He is a Deputy Lieutenant of Edinburgh.
