



'DAY OF ACTION'

I received reports from two contacts (last night and this morning) that Unionists, including senior political figures, are planning a 'day of action'. The 3rd March apparently was discussed as a possible date but it may even be before then and may include industrial stoppages, barricades and possibly the occupation of some Government buildings.
