

## PEACE TRAIN PRESS CONFERENCE TO ANNOUNCE NEW YEAR SHOPPING TRIP TO BELFAST

At 2pm this Saturday (December 21) the Peace Train Organisation will hold a Press Conference outside the Opera House, Belfast, to announce details of a Peace Train New Year Shopping Trip, to Belfast from Dublin, on Saturday January 18 1992, in support of the people and traders of Belfast.

The Peace Train Organisation will also this Saturday (Dec 21) distribute leaflets to shoppers in Belfast city centre, announcing the Peace Train New Year Shopping Trip and wishing the people of Belfast a Happy Christmas from the people of Dublin.

In a statement the Peace Train Chairpersons Sam McAughtry and Chris Hudson said:

"The people of Belfast are this week preparing to celebrate Christmas, despite a sustained campaign of IRA commercial vandalism against shops, hotels and theatres. Today many Dublin people are in Belfast for Christmas shopping. In January many will return on the Peace Train New Year Shopping Trip."

We, the ordinary people of Dublin and Belfast, have no wish to be hostile to each other. Two years ago, acting together, we kept the Dublin to Belfast rail line open for travel. Today, again acting together, we can help to keep Belfast open for business and shopping".


## IRA: STOP BOMBING CHRISTMAS


