NOTES

1. The above figures are an estimate and will need to be confirmed in the light of prevailing circumstances early in Phase 1.
2. Serials 7, 7A and 8 can be discounted in the event of an industrial dispute.
3. The level of reinforcement required from GB would be dependent upon a number of factors and is not possible to predict in advance. In the worst case (eg a wide-spread political strike by Loyalists), Serials 1, 2, 4, 8 and 9 might have to be provided from the mainland.
4. The figure at Serial 9 has been calculated on the basis that not all of the tankers would require individual escorts and that maximum use would be made of a convoy system.

Authorised purposes

1. - (1) Operation of the following transport services -
 - (a) stage services licensed as such;
 - (b) express services (excluding tours);
 - (c) services provided by employers of labour for taking their employees to or from their work by means of vehicles adapted to carry eight or more passengers;
 - (d) airport bus services;

SCHEDULE

Authorised Purposes

1. - (1) Purposes essential for the operation of any railway, light railway, tramway, road, water or air transport, canal, inland navigation, dock, harbour, pier or lighthouse undertaking.
- (2) Operation of airport operational or safety services (including fire and rescue, police and aerodrome lighting); aircraft maintenance facilities; terminal building lighting; en route air navigation obstruction lighting; air traffic control centres; technical services at aerodromes or the communications, radar and navigational facilities located throughout the country; maintenance centres operating transport to provide servicing facilities for remote navigational aids or radio stations.
- (3) Bunkering of ships carrying cargo to or from Northern Ireland including coastal vessels.
- (4) Operation of railways, docks and harbours.
2. Performance of police functions.
3. Operation of fire services.

 9. Purposes of any sewerage or sewage disposal undertaking, any undertaking for the collection or disposal of refuse (including toxic waste), or any drainage authority.
 - 10.- (1) Operation of telecommunication services (including broadcasting).
(2) Essential operations and maintenance of services by the Post Office, British Telecommunications the British Broadcasting Corporation, the Independent Broadcasting Authority or any programme contractor within the meaning of the Broadcasting Act 1981(a).
 - 11.- (1) Production, treatment or storage of and distribution of crude liquid petroleum or petroleum products used as fuel.
(2) Getting, dressing, manufacture or preparation for sale, distribution or sale of solid fuel.

12. - (1) Heating of residential accommodation or day centres or sheltered workshops dependent on oil for space heating used by Health and Social Services Boards and voluntary bodies for the provision of services essential for the health or well-being of persons on those premises who are ill, disabled, handicapped, infirm, pregnant, under the age of 5 or over the age of 60 years.

(2) Heating of special schools or colleges for the handicapped dependent on oil for space heating.
