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### Introduction

The NHSSB Trauma (of the 'Troubles') Advisory Panel was established in 1998 following the publication of two major reports:

' We Will Remember Them' Sir Kenneth Bloomfield KCB; and

'Living With The Trauma of The 'Troubles' DHSS Social Services Inspectorate

Both reports were instrumental in acknowledging the impact of the conflict in Northern Ireland on the lives of people living in communities throughout the province. They both highlighted the need for public services generally and health and social services specifically, to address the identified needs of 'victims' of 'The Troubles'. The DHSS Social Services Inspectorate stated "No-one knows the total number of people affected" but there is a growing recognition that many people have been affected in different ways and indeed some people are still experiencing traumatic events as a level of sectarianism remains resistant to peace initiatives.

Guided by the reports, the NHSSB Trauma Advisory Panel initiated training programmes for qualified professional staff providing services for people who had been affected by the conflict.



The Panel also published a comprehensive Trauma Support Services Directory in 2001 and also undertook a research project focusing on 'Displaced families as a result of sectarian conflict'. An inter-agency protocol was developed as a result of this latter piece of work.

Current initiatives include community based primary care projects, training programmes and clinical research and intervention approaches for people affected by conflict related trauma.

This revised Trauma Support Services Directory has been designed as a valuable resource in providing information for individuals, community and voluntary groups and agencies as well as professionals working with people who have been affected (directly or indirectly) by the 'Troubles'.

The Northern Area Trauma Advisory Panel recognises that the needs of 'victims' and 'survivors' are unique, and sometimes complex and ever changing. To this end we remain committed to the work we need to do in providing a forum for discussion and planning and co-ordinating services for people who have experienced trauma as a result of the 'Troubles'.

The Family Trauma Centre has been set up to help families deal with the impact of traumatic events. Services are provided by a team of clinical staff who help and support family members who have experienced a traumatic event. The centre is a regional resource working in partnership with statutory agencies, voluntary organisations and community groups.
