Plea over `Disappeared` bodies

The group set up to locate the remains of the so-called Disappeared is making another plea for fresh leads.

The Independent Commission for the Location of Victims Remains was recently given a map of a forest where the body of Gerry Evans, one of the victims, is claimed to be buried.

He was last seen in Castleblaney in March 1979.

Keiran Megraw, whose brother Brendan also went missing 30 years ago, says all the families are concerned that if there is no new information, the Commission could wind up their work.
