50 days, the two witnesses admitted beefing up their original accounts to suggest specialist forensic precautions were taken at one of the explosives finds allegedly connected to Hoey, when in reality they had not.

Defence lawyer Orlando Pownall QC had demanded their evidence should be thrown out, claiming it was dishonest.

Even senior Crown counsel Gordon Kerr QC accepted that the evidence should be treated with caution.

After Mr Justice Weir called for an investigation, a spokesman for Nuala O`Loan, the Northern Ireland police ombudsman, confirmed her team has launched a formal investigation.

It was said to be likely that investigators would seek to speak with the judge to establish his exact concerns.

The non-jury trial, which has become one of the biggest criminal proceedings in British legal history, is expected to finish this week.

But Mr Justice Weir will reserve his judgment for several weeks.
