Suspects held over journalist murder

Five people are still being questioned as part of a renewed investigation into the murder of Sunday World journalist Martin O`Hagan in Lurgan seven years ago.

He was shot dead as he walked home with his wife from a pub in the town.

The four men and one woman were detained in Banbridge and Lurgan and searches were carried out.

The arrests were made by officers from the PSNI`s Retrospective Murder Review Unit.

The suspects are being questioned at The Serious Crime Suite in Antrim Police Station.

At the time the Red Hand Defenders, a cover name for the UDA and the LVF, said they were responsible for the killing.
