Another arrest over Quinn murder

A man has been arrested in connection with the murder of south Armagh man Paul Quinn.

The 21 year-old victim was beaten to death at farm buildings near Castleblaney in County Monaghan last October.

Gardai say the latest arrest took place in County Monaghan on Sunday evening.

The man detained – who is aged in his 30s – is being held at Monaghan Garda Station.

Several arrests have been made since the killing but so far, no-one has been charged with the murder.
