Release in Quinn murder probe

A man being questioned by gardai about the murder of Paul Quinn has been released.

Mr Quinn, from Cullyhanna in south Armagh, was beaten to death by a gang of masked men in a farm shed in Monaghan last year.

His family have blamed the IRA locally for his death, a claim denied by the Republican movement.
