'Police officers were charged with murder and acquitted'

The Northern Ireland Police Ombudsman is to investigate one of the most controversial shoot-to-kill allegations against the security forces.

Nuala O'Loan has been asked by the Government to re-open files on the 1982 killing of three unarmed IRA men by Royal Ulster Constabulary officers after a chase through a check point in County Armagh, the Guardian newspaper reported tonight.

Gervaise McKerr was killed alongside Sean Burns and Eugene Toman following the pursuit near Lurgan.

Their car was riddled with bullets and the case has been subject to the highest courts in the UK and Europe.

"The Government has asked us to look at McKerr. But it's quite complex whether we have the legal power to investigate or not," Mrs O'Loan told the paper.

The Government has always denied that the security forces had a shoot-to-kill policy but the families have campaigned for a re-examination.
