### Troubles murders probe

A special commission to examine unsolved murders from the Troubles is being recommended by the Consultative Group on the Past.

A draft report by the group, chaired by Lord Eames and Denis Bradley, suggests the commission is established for a period of five years as a way of dealing with the past.

It is suggested that terrorists will be granted immunity from evidence they give as part of this process.

However, it will not amount to a full amnesty for terrorists and security force personnel.

Under the proposals the work of the Historical Enquiries Team would be subsumed.

Lord Eames and Mr Bradley are due to secretly brief the British-Irish Inter-Parliamentary Body which is meeting in Newcastle.
