Condemnation of Orange Hall attack

An Orange Hall has been attacked in County Down.

A memorial plaque was damaged and windows were smashed at Altnaveigh hall on Chancellor's Road in Newry.

It happened overnight on Saturday, but details have just emerged.

Ulster Unionist MLA for the area Danny Kennedy has described the attack as " *deeply provocative and sickening*".

Mr Kennedy said the incident was the "*latest in a long line of attacks*" on Altnaveigh which must be condemned by all sides in the community.
