Community Telegraph	Michael Higgins QC, who represents convicted Real IRA leader Michael McKevitt told the court: "I object to the description of my client as a terrorist." He said it was an "utterly pejorative term". The court heard earlier Mr McKevitt will be allowed to view the proceedings through a video link to Portlaoise Prison. Mr Justice Morgan smoothed over the exchange, reminding everyone that the matter will be decided on the evidence, not the language or content of the opening statement. The shelves of files on either side of the court room stood in mute support of the judge's observation. Their detail - mobile phone records, the evidence of an FBI informer, an account of an MI5 sting operation - will be telling.	NEW
