DUP MP Jeffrey Donaldson acknowledged that some victims found it hard to accept the powersharing arrangements at Stormont.

The Lagan Valley representative said his party leader fully respected those feelings and would not attend an event to which he was not invited.

"We understand and respect the sensitivities there are among some within the victims' sector who have suffered greatly as a result of atrocities like La Mon," he said.

"We appreciate that some victims find it difficult to accept what's happening at Stormont and Dr Paisley would not attend an event to which he was not invited."
