Donaldson inquest adjourned for a year

AN inquest into the murder of former senior Sinn Fein official Denis Donaldson has been adjourned for a year

after gardai said they were pursuing a new line of inquiry.

Superin	tendent Eugene McGovern told the inquest in Letterkenny yesterday that they were probing a new line
of inqui	ry, which was at an early stage and he requested an adjournment of one year.
A solicit	or for the Donaldson family said they did not object to the adjournment but if the case had not moved
on by th	at stage they would seek a date for completion.
Mr Don	aldson (56) was shot dead at a house in west Donegal in April 2006 just months after he admitted he
had bee	n a paid British agent.
One of t	he party's highest ranking officials, Mr Donaldson had been Sinn Fein head of administration before
his arres	st in 2002 in connection with an alleged spy ring at Stormont.
In Dece	mber 2005 he was
acquitte	d of the charges and was expelled from Sinn Fein the same month when he
admitte	d he had been in the pay of the British intelligence services for 20 years.
	wing the party Mr Donaldson moved to a house near Glenties in Co Donegal and it was there that he t dead in April 2006.
No-one	has ever been charged with his murder.
The inq	uest first opened in November 2007.
