3 names withheld from bomb memorial

RELATIVES of three Omagh bombing victims have withheld permission for their loved ones' names to be

inscribed on a new memorial.

The names will not appear on a list of the dead engraved on the walls inside a memorial garden close to the

scene of the 1998 Real IRA bomb which killed 29 people including a woman pregnant with twins.

The latest development came as it emerged that Church leaders in Omagh are to snub a 10th anniversary service organised by some families next Sunday.
