SINN FEIN "TRUTH" MARCH IS LAUGHABLE HYPOCRISY

Robin Newton East Belfast DUP Councillor and MLA has described the planned Sinn Fein "March for Truth" through Belfast as smacking of duplicity and deceit. Cllr Newton said:

"When Gerry Adams speaks about truth, he won't mention the number of innocent Roman Catholics murdered by the IRA, the thousands injured by republican thugs, the millions of pounds of damage IRA bombs did to property and the businessmen who faced extortion threats and were driven from Northern Ireland.

The proposed march, ending in a fascist like rally, will do nothing for truth. The reality is that Sinn Fein is finding it difficult to face up to their responsibilities as elected representatives. They are finding it tricky to leave the dark days of the terror campaign behind and especially difficult to wean their activists away from street politics.

This march and rally is to persuade potential dissidents that Sinn Fein's plan is still for a united Ireland within a republican agenda. Its hard-line theme is to disguise the fact that Sinn Fein is administering British rule in Northern Ireland."
