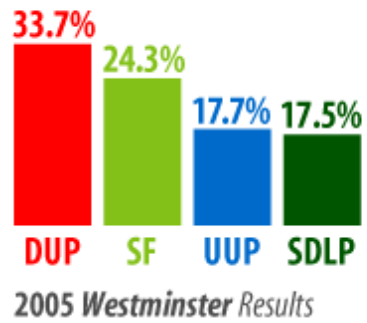
Commenting from Stormont, Mr Spratt said:
