SDLP Upper Bann MLA Dolores Kelly MLA has joined in the appeals for fresh information on the tenth anniversary of the murder of Adrian Lamph in Portadown. Mr Lamph was shot dead by loyalists while at work at Fair Green in the town.

Mrs Kelly stated:

"The murder of Adrian Lamph was a brutal, pre planned and organised shooting. It was yet another shameful act in which a young man with a young child and his future ahead of him had his life tragically taken away.

This murder happened during the day in a busy area of Portadown. There may have been scores of witnesses with who may be able to assist the police in their inquiries. Anyone with any information should come forward to the local PSNI immediately. I hope that today's appeal will jog people's memories or prick someone's conscience and help the family in their search for truth and justice."
