Speaking after the Policing Board met with the Omagh families in Omagh today SDLP Board member Dolores Kelly stated:

"Today's meeting was well attending and involved a detailed exchange of views. It was disappointing to note that some members of the Board did not attend todays meeting. They need to make themselves available to meet with the families as this is an issue which demands the full attention of all Board members.

A number of deep concerns remain about the monitoring and sharing of intelligence. The SDLP shares the families concerns around oversight and accountability.

At the time of the Omagh bomb the British and Irish Governments said that no stone would be left unturned in the search for the killers. Almost ten years on, there has been nothing but a series of false dawns, disappointments and shocking failures. The families deserve more than this. A cross border public inquiry could only help them in their search for answers, truth, and justice. The SDLP remains fully supportive of them in that search."
