The Family Trauma Centre is a regional resource service which works in partnership with statutory agencies, voluntary organizations and community groups, providing:

- A specialist service for psychological assessment and treatment of individuals up to the age of 18 years and families suffering primarily from trauma related to the Troubles and who reside within the four Health and Social Services Boards in Northern Ireland;
- A consultation service; and
